STABLE Account

Did you know that Ohio was the first to launch STABLE Accounts? STABLE Accounts are an investment account available to eligible individuals with disabilities and are made possible by the federal Achieving a Better Life Experience ("ABLE") Act. STABLE Accounts allow individuals with disabilities to save and invest money without losing eligibility for certain public benefits programs, like Medicaid or SSI. Earnings are not subject to federal income tax, so long as you spend them on "Qualified Disability Expenses".
